Update on SAU 48 precautions for COVID-19

Due to the fluid situation with COVID-19, we will be taking the following preventative measures to keep our students, staff and families as healthy as possible.

SAU 48 will be suspending the following activities from today, Thursday, March 12, 2020 until Tuesday, March 31, 2020:

- Afternoon and Evening Activities (except for local after school programs)
- Field Trips
- Assemblies/Guest Speakers
- Community Use of the Building (Annual town meetings will proceed as scheduled)
- Professional Development Conferences in NH and out of state
- Non-essential meetings

This will include Cultural Arts and any and all academic, co-curricular and/or athletic practices or competitions.

We will reassess these guidelines in consultation with state and local health authorities the last week of March to determine the April schedule. Please know that we are acting in the best interest of all and we will continually monitor and consult with our health care partners.
