

ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA)

In compliance with AHERA, SAU 48 is required to notify parents, teachers, and all other building occupants that an Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) is available to them in either the office of each school, or in the SAU office. The AMP details the location of asbestos in each building and provides a record of inspections, re-inspections, periodic surveillance, and removal of asbestos.

Periodic surveillance of Asbestos Containing Building Material (ACBM) is conducted by district personnel every six months and a thorough re-inspection of ACBM is conducted once every three years by the District's environmental consultant. The most recent inspection was conducted on April 25, 2019.
