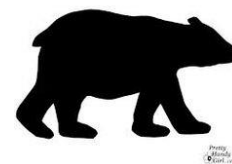

- 5:00 - 5:45 Extended day (This is for working parents who are unable to pick up their child by 5:00)

- If you need to pick up your child early from the program, the best times would be at 4:00 and 5:00.

*Homework time is held before enrichment programs. Each child is given the opportunity to work on homework. The program does not guarantee that each child will complete all homework assignments during this time. If your child participates in sports, that is considered their enrichment.

*Enrichment activities have limited sizes and specific goals to be accomplished throughout the program. Please do not sign your child up for a program knowing they will not be attending due to athletics, drama, or other extracurricular activities (in or out of school).

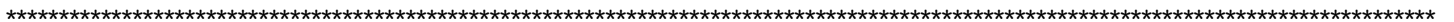
