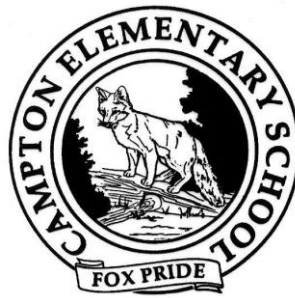

Free and Reduced Lunch Information

It's almost back to school time and the cost of breakfast and lunch for children can really put a strain on the budget of many families.

Fortunately, free and reduced meals and free milk are made available to a great many children through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).

If your family meets the income eligibility guidelines on the following page, please consider filling out the confidential application attached. You can save hundreds of dollars per year through this program for your family.

Unfortunately, If you do not apply for free and reduced lunch, and don't pay for your child's lunch, outstanding balances will continue to grow and will be forwarded to the following school year. As you will see on the following page, lunch costs \$2.70 and breakfast is \$1.50 this coming year. If you apply and qualify for reduced pricing, lunch will cost \$.40 and breakfast will be \$.30. You may also end up qualifying for free lunch and breakfast for your child(ren).

Please take time to read the guidelines and information on the following pages. Simply fill out the application today. It is completely confidential. You may also drop off the application in a sealed, addressed envelope to Campton Elementary School and we will forward it to the SAU office for you.
