CURRENT PRACTICES K-2 INSTRUCTION

- Kindergarten Computer Class 40 min./Week .02%
- Grade One Computer Class 40 min./Week .02%
- Grade two Computer Class 40 min./Week .02%

6.5 Hours/Day = 390 min/day and 1,950 min/week

ENHANCED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

- Classroom Centers provide an opportunity for students to engage in a variety of learning experiences that align with curriculum standards.
- The Unified Art's would have the ability to integrate subject matter in a digital format broadening student learning experiences.
 - Foreign Language (speaking and listening practice outside of the instructional period, students record themselves speaking and hear it back)
 - Music (record individual voices for playback purposes)
 - Art (Interactive tours of museums from around the world)
- Reading Intervention programs utilize IPAD technology to address.

Examples Include:

 - Site word activities
 - Narrating a story out and students can record and listen to how he/she sounds.
 - Letter identification applications that are all self correcting and can align with a center in the classroom allowing learning to be individualized
- Math Intervention programs utilize IPAD technology to provide a multitude of applications that address a wide range of student learning abilities.

EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

- Specialists such as Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech & Language Services all utilize technology to address specific student needs in an Individualized Educational Plan.

INSTRUCTIONAL GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTING ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN GRADES K-2 @ HCS

- Students will use an electronic device for instructional purposes only.
- Students will only have access to an electronic device to supplement or enrich the curriculum at the teachers discretion. (Devices will not be given to students to hold, keep or store on their own)
- All student devices will remain stored and not on student desks. (*Devices will not be given to students to hold, keep or store on their own*)
- Students will follow the 20-20-20 rule
 - 20 Minutes of use, look at something 20 feet away for 20 seconds.
